

Bear spotted in Murrysville

Capturing a video clip of a large black bear was about the last thing Bill Powers expected to see when checking one of his wildlife video systems last Friday morning but that's exactly what happened. The bear showed up on the video around 3:30 a.m. near Marlee Acres in Murrysville.

Powers, founder of PixController, Inc., was testing one of their new motion-activated wildlife video system products; which captured about ten minutes of a black bear. The bear is estimated to weigh around 300 pounds.

This is not the first time Powers has recorded a black bear in Murrysville on one of his wildlife systems. Back in May of 2004 he captured a video clip of a black bear feeding from a bird feeder in a relative's yard near Route 22.
